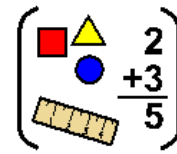


# Green Class

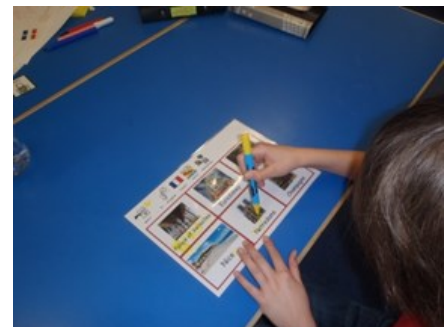

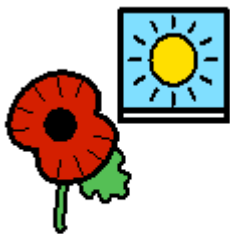
