

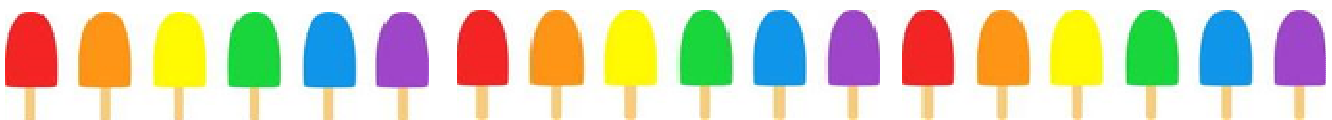
Green Class
