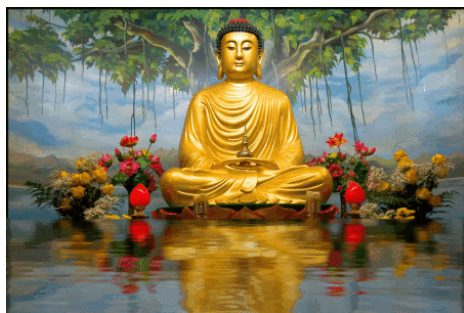
We have been developing our number skills in maths lessons and getting to grips with shapes and their properties.
