

## Limington House School

### Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch Up Funding

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support Year 7 pupils who did not achieve age related norms in reading and/or maths at the end of Key Stage 2. Year 7 literacy and numeracy catch-up premium was received by Limington House School for 2016/17 of £2500 (5 pupils) and anticipates £2500 (5 pupils) funding for 2017/18.

All Year 7 pupils at Limington House School attract a 'catch up' payment as they have not achieved age related norms at the end of Key Stage 2. The funding is used to meet the individual learning needs of these pupils. Each pupil's attainment and progress is analysed for each aspect of literacy and numeracy. Pupils have targets in literacy and numeracy and the funding supports them to achieve these targets. This includes enhanced staffing and specialist learning resources appropriate to the needs of individual pupils. Communication is a key skill which is supported throughout the school environment. Literacy and numeracy are embraced across the curriculum enabling pupils to make the highest possible individual progress.
