- Tell adults immediately if a problem arises.
- Treat everybody with respect.

Limington House School has the right to expect that the parents and carers will support their child's placement in the following way:

Maintain active communication with the school and an interest in their child's education by:

- Using the home/school contact books, attending parents' evenings and school events.

- Attending Annual Review and Education Health and Care Plan meetings.
- Give time to support learning at home, look after and return school equipment and books.
- Support the school's vision and aims - let the school know of any concerns or problems which might affect their child's behaviour or learning.
