primary toilet



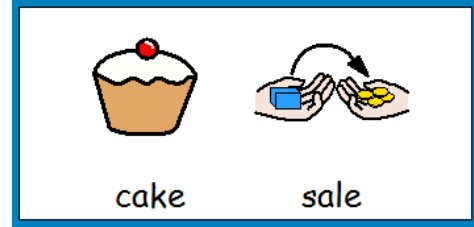
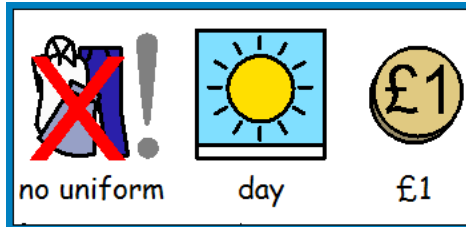
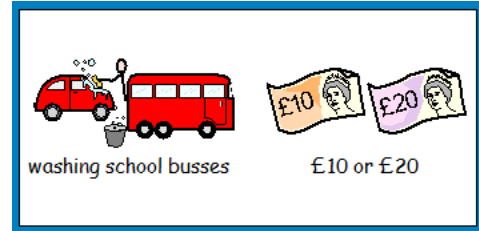
